G : Background ( 1 ) 6 x 6

Chapel Front ( 1 ) 6 x 6

G1 Background ( 1 ) 5.5 x 5.5

H : Chapel Body ( 1 ) 25.5 x 25.5

I : Chapel Front ( 2 ) 5.5 x 25.5

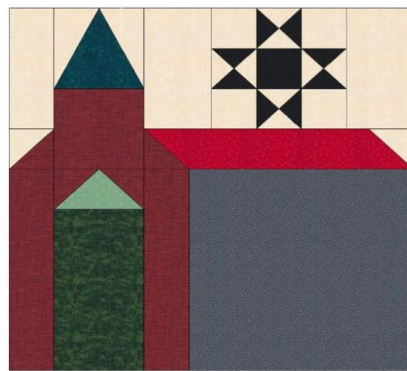
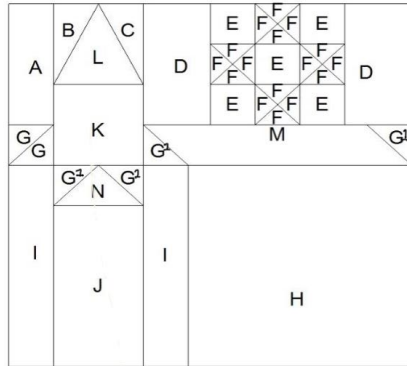
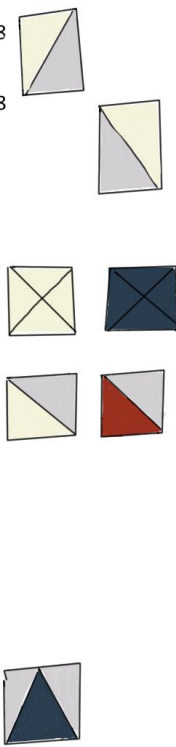
J : Chapel Door ( 1 ) 10.5 x 20.5

K : Chapel Front ( 1 ) 10.5 x 10.5

L : Steeple ( 1 ) 10.5 x 10.5

M : Roof ( 1 ) 5.5 x 30.5

N : Chapel Door ( 1 ) 5.5 x 10.5



- \*Using (2) G1 and N construct a traditional flying geese to use at the door top. Trim to 5.5 x 10.5
  - \*Using M and G1 construct the roof using a flip and fold method. Stitch down the center of G1 making sure to place the correct colors on the correct sides and stitching in the direction shown in the above picture.
  - \*Using G Background and G Chapel front make 1 HST trim to 5.5 x 5.5
  - \* Use the color layout to place all E and F pieces to make the star block
    - attach 1 D to each side of the star block
    - attach star block section to the top of roof section
  - \* For Steeple section, sew 1 background triangle to each side of steeple triangle. Trim to 10.5 x 10.5
- Use the layout picture to assemble the Jumbo Church block.
