



Confetti Triangles

These half-square triangles look like they're sprinkled across two different background colors!

Quilt Size: 42" x 49"

Block Size: 7" square

Number of Blocks: 42

YOU'LL NEED:

- (21) 5" charm squares from your Zest swatch pack
- 1/2 yard Wonder Coral* (for binding)*
- 1-1/4 yards Superior Solids Coral*
- 1-1/4 yards Superior Solids Carnation*
- 2-3/4 yards backing fabric*
- 50" x 57" piece of batting

*Additional fabric required

CUTTING:

From Wonder Coral:

(5) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding

From Coral Solid:

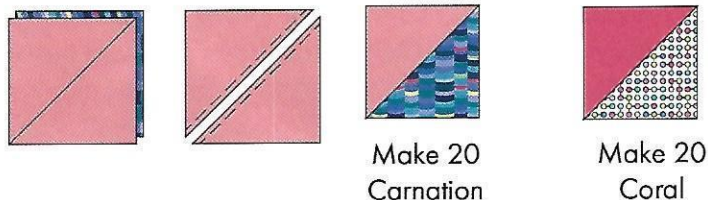
- (11) 5" squares
- (21) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces
- (21) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces
- (21) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces
- (21) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

From Carnation Solid:

- (11) 5" squares
- (21) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces
- (21) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces
- (21) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces
- (21) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

MAKE THE BLOCKS

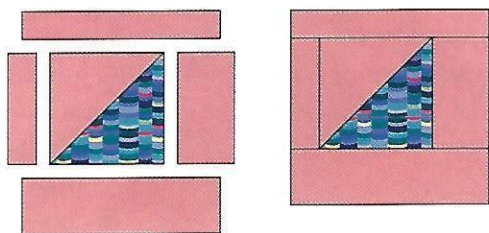
1 | Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (10) 5" Carnation squares. Layer a marked square right sides together with a 5" print square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the marked line, cut on the line, and press open. Square both HST units to measure 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make a total of (20) print/Carnation HST units. In the same way, make a total of (20) print/Coral HST units.



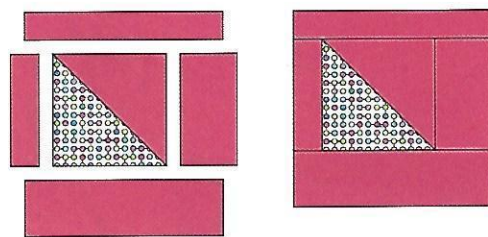
2 | Cut the remaining 5" print square, 5" Coral square and 5" Carnation square diagonally in half once. Pair (1) print triangle right sides together with (1) Coral triangle. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the long edge of the triangles. Press open and square to measure 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat with the second print triangle and (1) Carnation triangle. You should now have a total of (21) print/Carnation HST units and (21) print/Coral HST units.



3 | Sew (1) 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Carnation piece to the left side of one print/Carnation HST unit. Sew (1) 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Carnation piece to the right side. Sew (1) 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Carnation piece to the top of the unit and (1) 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Carnation piece to the bottom to complete (1) 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ " Carnation block. Make a total of (21) Carnation blocks. Note: Vary the orientation of the HST unit when adding the framed pieces. This will add variety and interest to the finished quilt.

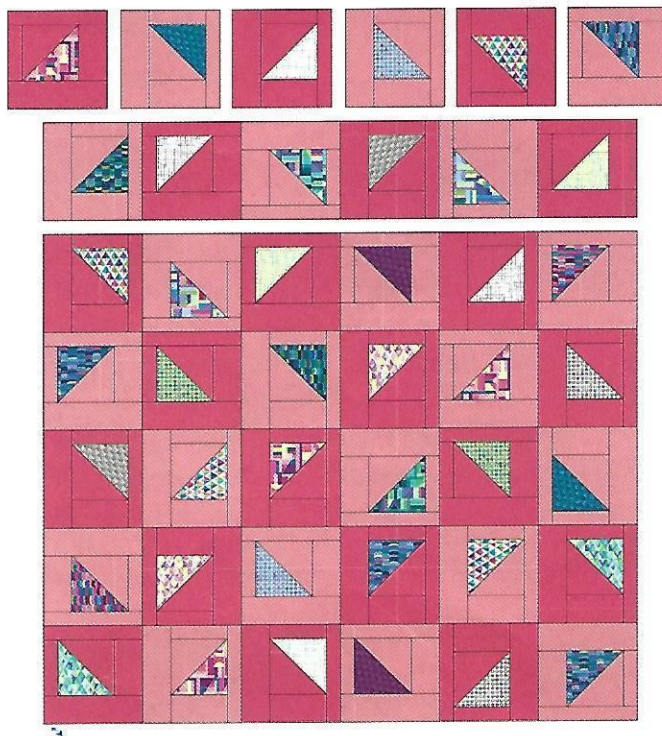


4 | Repeat step 3 using Coral pieces to make a total of (21) Coral blocks, again varying the orientation of the HST units in the blocks.



ASSEMBLE THE QUILT

1 | Lay out (3) Carnation and (3) Coral blocks into a row, rotating blocks and arranging prints as desired. Make a total of (7) block rows. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt top. Press the seams in each row in opposite directions.



FINISHING

1 | Layer the backing piece right side down, batting and quilt top right side up. Baste the layers to secure and quilt as desired. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top.

2 | Bind the quilt using the (5) 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Wonder Coral strips.
